Young Worker Violence Prevention Training

Teens Lead @ Work is a peer lead training that provides a 1 to 2 hour workplace violence prevention training to young workers, aged 14-19.



What is it?

- For youth ages 14-19
- Interactive training workshop lead by our Peer Trainers; all Peer Trainers completed an intensive 20 hour Train-the-Trainer program
- Curriculum includes
 - Introduction to hazard identification and control
 - Worker rights and responsibilities
 - Strategies for speaking up
 - Identification, prevention and mitigation for work place violence in common settings in the retail, healthcare and service sector settings.
 - Dealing with sexual harassment

Why schedule a training?

- Adequately trained young workers are less likely to be injured or killed on the job
- Empower teens with knowledge to protect themselves at their workplace
- Confidence to know how to prevent and handle any hazardous situation in the workplace
